Why are we here? Because God commands it ... Helping us to keep in mind His plan of salvation.

The Feast of Tabernacles ... The Feast of Ingathering ... picturing the salvation of hundreds of millions of people.

At least once a year, we go round the cycle of Holy Days ... and today is a time of rejoicing ... But, the good news is what it pictures.

Deuteronomy 16:13-15

"The Feast of Tabernacles Reviewed

"You shall <u>observe the Feast of Tabernacles seven days</u>, when you have gathered from your threshing floor and from your winepress. And <u>you</u> <u>shall rejoice in your feast</u>, you and your son and your daughter, your male servant and your female servant and the Levite, the stranger and the fatherless and the widow, who are within your gates. <u>Seven days you</u> <u>shall keep a sacred feast to the Lord your God</u> in the place which the Lord chooses, because the Lord your God will bless you in all your produce and in all the work of your hands, so that <u>you surely rejoice</u>."

We shall rejoice in our Feast ... everybody must rejoice for 7 days.

<u>Nehemiah 8:14–18</u>

"And they found written in the Law, which the Lord had commanded by Moses, that the children of Israel <u>should dwell in booths during the</u> <u>feast of the seventh month</u>, and that they should announce and proclaim in all their cities and in Jerusalem, saying, "Go out to the mountain, and bring olive branches, branches of oil trees, myrtle branches, palm branches, and branches of leafy trees, to <u>make booths</u>, as it is written." Then the people went out and brought them and made themselves booths, each one on the roof of his house, or in their courtyards or the courts of the house of God, and in the open square of the Water Gate and in the open square of the Gate of Ephraim. So the whole assembly of those who had returned from the captivity made booths and sat under the booths; for since the days of Joshua the son of Nun until that day the children of Israel had not done so. And there was very great gladness. <u>Also day by</u> day, from the first day until the last day, he read from the Book of the Law of God. And they kept the feast seven days; and on the eighth day there was a sacred assembly, according to the prescribed manner."

We should endeavour to enjoy these days.

Exodus 23:14-17

" Three Annual Feasts

"<u>Three times you shall keep a feast (Hebrew: Chag) to Me</u> in the year: You shall keep <u>the Feast of Unleavened Bread</u> (you shall eat unleavened bread seven days, as I commanded you, at the time appointed in the month of Abib, for in it you came out of Egypt; none shall appear before Me empty); and <u>the Feast of Harvest</u>, the firstfruits of your labors which you have sown in the field; and <u>the Feast of Ingathering</u> at the end of the year, when you have gathered in the fruit of your labors from the field.

"Three times in the year all your males shall appear before the Lord God."

There are two harvests ... the harvest of the Firstfruits. Then the Feast of Ingathering ... of people.

Matthew 9:35-38

Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, <u>teaching</u> in their synagogues, <u>preaching the gospel of the kingdom</u>, and <u>healing</u> every sickness and every disease among the people. (Christ had a three part ministry) But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd. Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the labourers are few. Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out <u>labourers into His harvest</u>." (The harvest of people).

<u>Isaiah 32:1-4</u>

Behold, a king will reign in righteousness,
And princes (God's saints) will rule with justice.
A man will be as a hiding place from the wind,
And a cover from the tempest,
As rivers of water in a dry place,
As the shadow of a great rock in a weary land.
The eyes of those who see will not be dim, (People will have proper understanding in The World Tomorrow)
And the ears of those who hear will listen.
Also the heart of the rash will understand knowledge,
And the tongue of the stammerers will be ready to speak plainly."

<u>Isaiah 32:12-18</u>

" People shall mourn upon their breasts For the pleasant fields, for the fruitful vine. On the land of my people will come up thorns and briers, Yes, on all the happy homes in the joyous city; Because the palaces will be forsaken, The bustling city will be deserted. The forts and towers will become lairs forever, A joy of wild donkeys, a pasture of flocks— Until the Spirit is poured upon us from on high, And the wilderness becomes a fruitful field, And the fruitful field is counted as a forest. Then justice will dwell in the wilderness, And righteousness remain in the fruitful field. The work of righteousness will be peace, And the effect of righteousness, quietness and assurance forever. My people will dwell in a peaceful habitation, In secure dwellings, and in quiet resting places."

Isaiah 35:1–10 THE WORLD TOMORROW

The wilderness and the wasteland shall be glad for them, And the desert shall rejoice and blossom as the rose; It shall blossom abundantly and rejoice, Even with joy and singing. The glory of Lebanon shall be given to it, The excellence of Carmel and Sharon. They shall see the glory of the Lord, The excellency of our God. Strengthen the weak hands, And make firm the feeble knees. Say to those who are fearful-hearted, "Be strong, do not fear! Behold, your God will come with vengeance, With the recompense of God; He will come and save you." Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, And the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped. (Physically and spiritually) Then the lame shall leap like a deer, And the tongue of the dumb sing. For waters shall burst forth in the wilderness, And streams in the desert. The parched ground shall become a pool, And the thirsty land springs of water; In the habitation of jackals, where each lay, There shall be grass with reeds and rushes. A highway shall be there, and a road, And it shall be called the Highway of Holiness. The unclean shall not pass over it, But it shall be for others. Whoever walks the road, although a fool, Shall not go astray. No lion shall be there, Nor shall any ravenous beast go up on it; It shall not be found there. But the redeemed shall walk there,

And the ransomed of the Lord shall return, And come to Zion with singing, With everlasting joy on their heads. They shall obtain joy and gladness, And sorrow and sighing shall flee away."

<u>Isaiah 11:1-11</u>

There shall come forth a Rod from the stem of Jesse, (The Messiah) And a Branch shall grow out of his roots. The Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him, The Spirit of wisdom and understanding, The Spirit of counsel and might, The Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord. His delight is in the fear of the Lord, And He shall not judge by the sight of His eyes, Nor decide by the hearing of His ears; But with righteousness He shall judge the poor, And decide with equity for the meek of the earth; He shall strike the earth with the rod of His mouth, And with the breath of His lips He shall slay the wicked. Righteousness shall be the belt of His loins, And faithfulness the belt of His waist. "The wolf also shall dwell with the lamb, The leopard shall lie down with the young goat, The calf and the young lion and the fatling together; And a little child shall lead them. The cow and the bear shall graze; Their young ones shall lie down together; And the lion shall eat straw like the ox. The nursing child shall play by the cobra's hole, And the weaned child shall put his hand in the viper's den. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all My holy mountain, For the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord As the waters cover the sea. "And in that day there shall be a Root of Jesse,

Who shall stand as a banner to the people;

For the Gentiles shall seek Him, And His resting place shall be glorious." It shall come to pass in that day That the Lord shall set His hand again the second time To recover the remnant of His people who are left,"

<u>Romans 10:13-18</u>

" For "whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved." How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written:

"How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, Who bring glad tidings of good things!"

But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Isaiah says, "Lord, who has believed our report?" So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

But I say, have they not heard? Yes indeed: "Their sound has gone out to all the earth, And their words to the ends of the world.""

Zephaniah 3:14-17

Sing, O daughter of Zion!
Shout, O Israel!
Be glad and rejoice with all your heart,
O daughter of Jerusalem!
The Lord has taken away your judgments,
He has cast out your enemy.
The King of Israel, the Lord, is in your midst;
You shall see disaster no more.
In that day it shall be said to Jerusalem:
"Do not fear;
Zion, let not your hands be weak.
The Lord your God in your midst,
The Mighty One, will save;

He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet you with His love, <u>He will rejoice over you with singing</u>." (Jesus sings)

Daniel 7:13-14

" "I was watching in the night visions, And behold, One like the Son of Man, Coming with the clouds of heaven! He came to the Ancient of Days, And they brought Him near before Him. <u>Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom,</u> <u>That all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him</u>. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, (Jesus Kingdom will never be destroyed) Which shall not pass away, And His kingdom the one Which shall not be destroyed."

<u>Daniel 7:27</u>

" Then the kingdom and dominion, And the greatness of the kingdoms under the whole heaven, Shall be given to the people, the saints of the Most High. His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, And all dominions shall serve and obey Him.'" (Jesus will be helped by His saints to rule).

<u>Jeremiah 31:27–34</u>

""Behold, the days are coming, says the Lord, that I will sow the house of Israel and the house of Judah with the seed of man and the seed of beast. And it shall come to pass, that as I have watched over them to pluck up, to break down, to throw down, to destroy, and to afflict, so I will watch over them to build and to plant, says the Lord. In those days they shall say no more:

'The fathers have eaten sour grapes, And the children's teeth are set on edge.' But every one shall die for his own iniquity; every man who eats the sour grapes, his teeth shall be set on edge.

"Behold, the days are coming, says the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah— not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband to them, says the Lord. But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. No more shall every man teach his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, 'Know the Lord,' for they all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the Lord. For I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more.""

We should voluntarily want to go God's way. In the future, people will not be hostile to God and His word. Everyone will know God (My Law = Torah = Instruction Covenant --- Brit Ish --- man)

<u>Isaiah 25:6-9</u>

" And in this mountain The Lord of hosts will make for all people <u>A feast of choice pieces</u>, <u>A feast of wines on the lees</u>, Of fat things full of marrow, Of well-refined wines on the lees. And He will destroy on this mountain The surface of the covering cast over all people, And the veil that is spread over all nations. (That veil will be destroyed) <u>He will swallow up death forever</u>, And <u>the Lord God will wipe away tears from all faces;</u> The rebuke of His people He will take away from all the earth; For the Lord has spoken. And it will be said in that day: <u>"Behold, this is our God;</u> <u>We have waited for Him, and He will save us.</u> <u>This is the Lord;</u> <u>We have waited for Him;</u> <u>We will be glad and rejoice in His salvation."</u>

<u>Ezekiel 34:23-31</u>

" I will establish one shepherd over them, and he shall feed them—My servant David. He shall feed them and be their shepherd. (King David will be King over Israel in The World Tomorrow) And I, the Lord, will be their God, and My servant David a prince among them; I, the Lord, have spoken. "I will make a covenant of peace with them, and cause wild beasts to cease from the land; and they will dwell safely in the wilderness and sleep in the woods. I will make them and the places all around My hill a blessing; and I will cause showers to come down in their season; there shall be showers of blessing. Then the trees of the field shall yield their fruit, and the earth shall yield her increase. They shall be safe in their land; and they shall know that I am the Lord, when I have broken the bands of their yoke and delivered them from the hand of those who enslaved them. And they shall no longer be a prey for the nations, nor shall beasts of the land devour them; but they shall dwell safely, and no one shall make them afraid. I will raise up for them a garden of renown, and they shall no longer be consumed with hunger in the land, nor bear the shame of the Gentiles anymore. Thus they shall know that I, the Lord their God, am with them, and they, the house of Israel, are My people," says the Lord God.' "

"You are My flock, the flock of My pasture; you are men, and <u>I am your</u> <u>God," says the Lord God."</u>

<u>Jeremiah 31:1-9</u>

"At the same time," says the Lord, "I will be the God of all the families of Israel, and they shall be My people."

Thus says the Lord:

"The people who survived the sword Found grace in the wilderness—

Israel, when I went to give him rest." The Lord has appeared of old to me, saying: "Yes, I have loved you with an everlasting love; Therefore with lovingkindness I have drawn you. Again I will build you, and you shall be rebuilt, O virgin of Israel! You shall again be adorned with your tambourines, And shall go forth in the dances of those who rejoice. You shall yet plant vines on the mountains of Samaria; The planters shall plant and eat them as ordinary food. For there shall be a day When the watchmen will cry on Mount Ephraim, 'Arise, and let us go up to Zion, To the Lord our God.' " For thus says the Lord: "Sing with gladness for Jacob, And shout among the chief of the nations; Proclaim, give praise, and say, 'O Lord, save Your people, The remnant of Israel! Behold, I will bring them from the north country, And gather them from the ends of the earth, Among them the blind and the lame, The woman with child And the one who labors with child, together; A great throng shall return there. They shall come with weeping, And with supplications I will lead them. I will cause them to walk by the rivers of waters, In a straight way in which they shall not stumble; For I am a Father to Israel, And Ephraim is My firstborn."

<u>Jeremiah 31:11–14</u>

" For the Lord has redeemed Jacob, And ransomed him from the hand of one stronger than he. Therefore they shall come and sing in the height of Zion, Streaming to the goodness of the Lord— For wheat and new wine and oil, For the young of the flock and the herd; Their souls shall be like a well-watered garden, And they shall sorrow no more at all. "Then shall the virgin rejoice in the dance, And the young men and the old, together; For I will turn their mourning to joy, Will comfort them, And make them rejoice rather than sorrow. I will satiate the soul of the priests with abundance, And My people shall be satisfied with My goodness, says the Lord.""

Jeremiah 33:11-16

" the voice of joy and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride, the voice of those who will say: "Praise the Lord of hosts,

For the Lord is good,

For His mercy endures forever"— and of those who will bring the sacrifice of praise into the house of the Lord. For I will cause the captives of the land to return as at the first,' says the Lord.

"Thus says the Lord of hosts: 'In this place which is desolate, without man and without beast, and in all its cities, there shall again be a dwelling place of shepherds causing their flocks to lie down. In the cities of the mountains, in the cities of the lowland, in the cities of the South, in the land of Benjamin, in the places around Jerusalem, and in the cities of Judah, the flocks shall again pass under the hands of him who counts them,' says the Lord.

'Behold, the days are coming,' says the Lord, 'that I will perform that good thing which I have promised to the house of Israel and to the house of Judah:

'In those days and at that time I will cause to grow up to David A Branch of righteousness; He shall execute judgment and righteousness in the earth. In those days Judah will be saved, And Jerusalem will dwell safely. And this is the name by which she will be called: THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.'"

Zechariah 8:1-8

Again the word of the Lord of hosts came, saying, "Thus says the Lord of hosts: 'I am zealous for Zion with great zeal; With great fervor I am zealous for her.' "Thus says the Lord: 'I will return to Zion, And dwell in the midst of Jerusalem. Jerusalem shall be called the City of Truth, The Mountain of the Lord of hosts, The Holy Mountain. ""Thus says the Lord of hosts: 'Old men and old women shall again sit In the streets of Jerusalem. Each one with his staff in his hand Because of great age. The streets of the city Shall be full of boys and girls Playing in its streets. "Thus says the Lord of hosts: 'If it is marvelous in the eyes of the remnant of this people in these days, Will it also be marvelous in My eyes?' Says the Lord of hosts. "Thus says the Lord of hosts: 'Behold, I will save My people from the land of the east And from the land of the west: I will bring them back, And they shall dwell in the midst of Jerusalem. They shall be My people And I will be their God. In truth and righteousness.

Zechariah 8:20-22

" "Thus says the Lord of hosts: 'Peoples shall yet come, Inhabitants of many cities; The inhabitants of one city shall go to another, saying, "Let us continue to go and pray before the Lord, And seek the Lord of hosts. I myself will go also." Yes, many peoples and strong nations Shall come to seek the Lord of hosts in Jerusalem, And to pray before the Lord.'"

<u>Micah 4:1-7</u>

Now it shall come to pass in the latter days That the mountain of the Lord's house

Shall be established on the top of the mountains,

And shall be exalted above the hills;

And peoples shall flow to it.

Many nations shall come and say,

"Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the Lord,

To the house of the God of Jacob;

<u>He will teach us His ways,</u>

And we shall walk in His paths."

For out of Zion the law shall go forth,

And the word of the Lord from Jerusalem.

He shall judge between many peoples,

And rebuke strong nations afar off;

They shall beat their swords into plowshares,

And their spears into pruning hooks; (this will be in the early years of The Millenium)

Nation shall not lift up sword against nation,

Neither shall they learn war anymore.

But <u>everyone shall sit under his vine and under his fig tree</u>, (in peace)

And no one shall make them afraid;

For the mouth of the Lord of hosts has spoken.

For all people walk each in the name of his god, But we will walk in the name of the Lord our God Forever and ever. "In that day," says the Lord, "I will assemble the lame, I will gather the outcast And those whom I have afflicted; I will make the lame a remnant, And the outcast a strong nation; So the Lord will reign over them in Mount Zion From now on, even forever."

Amos 9:13-15

" "Behold, the days are coming," says the Lord, "When the plowman shall overtake the reaper, (so much abundance) And the treader of grapes him who sows seed; The mountains shall drip with sweet wine, And all the hills shall flow with it. I will bring back the captives of My people Israel; (early in The Millenium) They shall build the waste cities and inhabit them; They shall plant vineyards and drink wine from them; They shall also make gardens and eat fruit from them. I will plant them in their land, And no longer shall they be pulled up From the land I have given them," Says the Lord your God."

Tremendous blessings and abundance ... and The Feast pictures those days.

Acts 3:19-23

"<u>Repent</u> therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, <u>so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord</u>, and that He may send Jesus Christ, who was preached to you before, whom heaven must receive until the times of restoration of all things, which God has spoken by the mouth of all His holy prophets since the world began. For Moses truly said to the fathers, 'The Lord your God will raise up for you a Prophet like me from your brethren. Him you shall hear in all things, whatever He says to you. And it shall be that every soul who will not hear that Prophet (Jesus Christ) shall be utterly destroyed from among the people.'"
